PNG University of Technology to host annual Open Day

Preparations are underway at the Papua New Guinea University of Technology (PNGUoT) for the annual Open Day on Friday, 25th of July 2025.

The theme for this year, ***“Explore Pathways to a World-Class Education”***, focuses on giving grade 12 students (school leavers) in Lae City and Morobe province the opportunity to learn about educational opportunities and pathways offered by the university.

Chairman of the Open Day Organising Committee, Associate Professor Dr Patrick Michael, said invitations have been extended to secondary schools within Lae City and Morobe Province to attend the event.

Dr Michael urges all secondary schools within the province and welcomes those in the nearby lower Highlands and Madang provinces to send a representative to the event.

“I cordially invite the Provincial Guidance Officers, Secondary School Inspectors and Principals of secondary schools around the country to attend this Open Day event and be informed about PNGUoT’s admission requirements and processes,” he added.

PNGUoT has five Faculties (Built Environment, Engineering, Humanities, Natural Resources and Sciences) and 13 academic schools.

The planned event will be a fun and informative event with activities that showcase programs offered and career pathways, displays of student projects and lab experiments, a tour of the faculty and academic schools, information about admissions requirements, including the STAT PNG, and study opportunities through online and distance learning.

“The event will also feature key support services at the university, like the library, clinic, and students’ support and facilities centre to talk to students and teachers on important services related to social, security, health, and spiritual wellbeing of students provided by the University”, Dr Michael said.
